Purpose of role

Join our friendly team at the Home store in this important role in the stock room to sort through and prepare donated items for sale in the shop to raise as much money as possible for Thames Hospice.

Main tasks

- Looking through donated items to decide what can or cannot be sold
- Steaming soft furnishings and clothing items using the steaming machine
- Sorting through jewellery, accessories, bric-a-brac, CDs and DVDs
- Pricing and labelling the items using the tagging machine and gift aid labels
- Hanging items or sorting into categories ready to go into the shop
- Capturing Gift Aid donations and processing on the system

- The shop manager and other employees will be available give advice and assist you, as well as other experienced volunteers in the team
- You will receive mandatory Health and Safety training
