



Thames Hospice London Marathon T&Cs

By accepting a Thames Hospice charity place for the 2027 TCS London Marathon you are agreeing to:

1. Pay a non-refundable registration fee of £50 with a deadline of 7 days to complete the payment. Until this is paid, your place is not confirmed.
2. Raise a minimum of £2,500 (not including gift aid or registration fee)
3. Once you have completed our Thames Hospice London Marathon application form you will receive and email confirming completion. Please note: completing the application form **does not** confirm your place in the London Marathon for 2027.
4. Notify Thames Hospice immediately if you can no longer participate. Withdrawal does not guarantee deferral, and re-application may be required, your registration fee is non-refundable.
5. You allow Thames Hospice to use your name, photograph, video, and any comments or feedback in future publicity, fundraising materials, and promotions. This may include printed materials, our website, social media channels, and reports. If you do not wish for your name or image to be used in this way, please let us know via event@thameshospice.org.uk
6. If you are successful and allocated a charity place, Thames Hospice will let you know in September 2026.
7. The deadline for applications is 31 July 2026, we will be allocating places on a rolling basis so do get your application in ASAP. If there is high demand for places we may bring this date forward with short notice.
8. You must be at least 18 years old on the day of the London Marathon.
9. You agree that the event organisers, sponsors, or any person involved in the organisation of the event shall not be liable for any injury, accidents, loss or damage suffered by you in, or by reason of the event, however such may be caused.

Sponsorship

10. Sponsorship money may not be given to or shared with any other organisation.
11. Sponsorship forms/money collected for the London Marathon must be paid in directly to Thames Hospice within a month of the date of the event.
12. If you have not reached your sponsorship target by 7 June 2027, you will need to agree a plan with Thames Hospice to either raise or donate the remaining funds
13. Cheques are made payable to Thames Hospice and should be sent directly to Thames Hospice Fundraising Team, Windsor Road, Maidenhead, SL6 2DN and not any of our charity shops
14. If the Marathon is cancelled and you do not transfer to another event, you are responsible for informing your sponsors that you will no longer be participating. You must confirm with them whether they are happy for their donations to still be given to Thames Hospice. If you are using sponsorship forms for fundraising, all collected



sponsorship forms and funds should either be forwarded to us or returned to your sponsors, based on their wishes.

Data Protection

15. By registering, you consent to the processing of your personal and sensitive data for event purposes only. By filling out the London Marathon application form, you agree to this use of your data. We will securely store your data and take reasonable precautions to protect it. Your data will never be sold or shared.
16. In the future, we may contact you about our charity activities and events. Please use the application form process to opt in or out of communications accordingly.
